It went through several stages of development, expanding in both academic programs and facilities, until it became an independent university center in 2001 and was officially recognized as a university in 2012. Since 2014, it has carried its current name. Today, the university comprises eight faculties and a medical annex, with over 25,000 students and 1,100 faculty members. It also hosts a research unit focused on renewable energy in desert regions, a business incubator, and an artificial intelligence center.

Research:


Research at El Oued University is instrumental in understanding and addressing poverty, particularly through faculty-led studies that explore poverty's impact on Algerian society and its connections with public policy. Faculties and research hubs such as the Laboratory of Islamic Sciences contribute by researching Islamic charity and donation practices, aligning cultural and academic insights to alleviate poverty. Key research topics include:

• Impact of Endowments: The faculty of Islamic sciences at the university of El Oued explored extensively how endowments as a means of fostering collective contributions toward knowledge and societal development and help in generating sustainable resources independent of traditional state funding. By leveraging these funds for education, healthcare, and other community services, such mechanisms reduce financial burdens on vulnerable populations and help alleviate poverty.









• Education and Poverty: Research addresses how education policies can break intergenerational poverty, focusing on education access and outcomes in low-income groups. Our collaboration for inclusive solutions with the High Council for the Arabic Language and the Ministry of National Education demonstrates a collaborative effort to address systemic issues in education. This collaboration reflects a commitment to implementing policies and programs that reduce educational inequalities, which are often closely tied to economic disparities.

• Social Protection Programs: Our researchers conducted a critical review by evaluating the Zakat Fund's role in El Oued as a social protection program to combat poverty. It highlights the fund's initial success in reducing poverty rates but identifies challenges in recent years due to declining collections. The study emphasizes the importance of strengthening such community-driven social protection mechanisms to ensure sustainability and equitable distribution. It provides valuable insights into enhancing local poverty alleviation efforts, aligning with SDG 1.3's focus on





sustainable social protection systems. By offering recommendations to optimize Zakat contributions and their management, the research supports innovative and localized solutions to address poverty effectively. analyse the effectiveness of cash transfers and food aid to reduce poverty among vulnerable populations.

The university actively disseminates these findings through publications and conferences, fostering knowledge-sharing on poverty alleviation strategies.


Transition to Fourth-Generation University

 for visually impaired individuals by detecting obstacles and providing audio feedback.

A recent study applied the Theory of Planned Behaviour to examine the drivers of organic food purchasing intentions, integrating factors such as product-specific attitudes and future orientation. Findings suggest that while product-specific attitudes and availability positively impact organic food consumption, subjective norms are less influential. These insights offer valuable recommendations for promoting sustainable consumption patterns, aligning with Algeria's national objectives to reduce the environmental impact of consumption.

Education and Community Engagement

The University of El Oued actively engages students, staff, and the broader community in sustainability education and responsible consumption practices.

The university integrates sustainability principles into its academic curriculum, particularly within environmental science and engineering courses.
