The University of El Oued, in collaboration with Riga Technical University (RTU), Latvia, is pleased to announce the opening of applications for Erasmus+ KA171 Staff Mobility opportunities for the second semester of the 2026/2027 academic year.

Mobility Details

- Host Institution: Riga Technical University (RTU), Latvia
- Mobility Type: Erasmus+ KA171 Staff Mobility
- Number of available positions: **5 positions (All Over Algeria)**
- Mobility Period: Second Semester of the Academic Year 2026/2027
- Teaching Language: English

The mobility enables academic staff to deliver teaching activities at RTU, strengthen international cooperation, expand professional networks, exchange teaching practices, and develop future academic collaboration. Training activities and individual meetings may also be included where applicable.

Teaching Requirements

- Staff Mobility for Teaching normally requires a minimum of 8 teaching hours during the mobility period.
- For Combined Staff Mobility for Teaching and Training, the minimum teaching requirement may be reduced to 4 teaching hours, together with relevant training activities at the host university.
- Proposed teaching activities should, where possible, be integrated into regular academic activities or courses offered by RTU.

Erasmus+ Funding

There is no participation fee. Selected participants may receive Erasmus+ financial support provided by Riga Technical University, in accordance with applicable Erasmus+ KA171 rules and the available project budget. Mobility places may be shared among partner institutions in the same region, and applications are evaluated competitively on merit.

Eligibility and Selection Criteria

- Mobility rationale and motivation.
- Quality and relevance of the proposed mobility plan; a detailed teaching or mobility plan is strongly recommended.
- Minimum B2 level of English.
- Priority may be given to staff members who have not previously participated in an Erasmus+ mobility.
- Priority may also be given to applicants who have obtained an invitation letter from the relevant RTU department or academic unit.

Selection Process

1. Candidates submit their applications to the University of El Oued within the announced deadline.
2. Applications are evaluated according to the Erasmus+ KA171 and RTU selection criteria.
3. The selected candidates are officially nominated to Riga Technical University by the International Relations Office / Erasmus+ Coordinator of the University of El Oued.
4. Nominated staff members will then be invited by the RTU Erasmus+ Coordinator to complete the RTU online application procedure.
5. The relevant RTU department will review each nominated candidate's application and decide whether to accept or reject it.
6. Riga Technical University will notify the candidate and the University of El Oued of the final decision.
7. *The RTU nomination platform is reserved for the official use of the University of El Oued administration and is not published as part of this call for applications.*

Required Documents

- Updated CV in English.
- Motivation Letter.
- Proposed Mobility / Teaching Plan.
- English Language Proficiency Certificate – minimum B2.
- Invitation Letter from Riga Technical University, if available.
- Valid Passport.
- Any additional documents required during the nomination or application process.

Application Deadline

15 October 2026

The mobility will take place during the second semester of the 2026/2027 academic year. The internal application deadline at the University of El Oued is **15 October 2026**. Applications submitted after **15 October 2026** will not be considered.
